

- Driver age must be between 3-10 years old.
 - Driver must be at least 3 years old by June 1st, 2024.
 - Drivers turning 11 years old during the race season must have birthdates AFTER August 1st, 2024
 - Please be honest for the kids
- All drivers must supply their own Power Wheel
- There will be TWO vehicle classes for the 2024 season
 - Stock (12v)
 - Power Mod

SAFETY

- All drivers are required to wear a helmet (Bicycle helmets are acceptable)
- Additional protective equipment is recommended but not required. May be worn at parent discretion (ie – elbow pads, full face helmet, gloves, clothing type)
- All drivers are required to wear closed toed, sneaker style shoes (no sandals, flip-flops, heels, clogs)
 - The designated parent/guardian in the 'Pit Area' is also required to wear closed toed shoes.
- Drivers are NOT allowed to get out of their vehicle until the race ends or an official instructs them to
- Powered Vehicles (competing or not) are NOT allowed to be driven around the race area when entering/exiting the event. This is to protect all vehicles from potential damage (including automobiles in the parking lot)
- Seat Belt required on all vehicles, all ages
- Drivers may only be registered to ONE vehicle class per season
- Vehicle may only be registered to ONE class per season
- Vehicle may only be registered to ONE driver (every driver must have their own as they will compete with every driver in their field)
- All Vehicles must originate from a store bought Power Wheel type vehicle (Any brand is allowed)
- All Vehicles must be inspected prior to competing (Tech Inspection)
- Vehicles may only be repaired once inspected. Drivers (Parents) will be granted reasonable time to make any safety repairs as necessary. Any mechanical repairs will be granted on a case by case basis with realistic time allowed to make necessary repairs. A Staff Tech Official must be present during any/all repairs. Any safety or mechanical failures that cannot be repaired in a realistic time without excessive delay to the competition will not be granted.
- All Vehicles must be an enclosed cabin structure. Vehicles where the legs are on the outside (ie - 4 wheelers) are not allowed. Driver's legs must be inside the vehicle during competition (not hanging over the sides or front).
- All Vehicles are required to have doors attached and closed during competition. If a vehicle does not come with doors from the factory, a safety net/strap must be fastened to the vehicle door section enclosing the driver inside.
- Track will provide traction assistance at start line as available.
- Factory gearboxes are required on all Vehicles (No chains or belts)
- Boost buttons NOT allowed.
- Please remember to fully charge batteries prior to the event. Re-charging is NOT permitted during the event. Battery swaps will be permitted at the halfway point in the event. If a battery fails during a race, that race will NOT be re-run, however this will be considered a mechanical failure and you will be permitted to make repairs.

CLASSES

STOCK CLASS

- "Buy & Assemble" Class
- NO Mechanical modifications are allowed
- Cosmetic alterations are allowed including but not limited to painting, stickers/decals, vinyl wraps. Be Creative!
- All parts of vehicle must be installed (no omitting parts please)
- 12-volt max. No Battery Upgrades
- All Tires must be completely Stock (No rubber added)
- Age 3-4 use of a Parental Remote Control is allowed.

POWER-MOD CLASS

- "Modified" Class
- Mechanical modifications are allowed.
- Motor swaps are allowed (Must be BRUSHED motors)
- Cosmetic alterations are allowed including but not limited to painting, stickers/decals, vinyl wraps. Be Creative!
- Can upgrade battery to 24v max (Vehicle is allowed to have up to 2 batteries with a combined value up to 24v)
- May add rubber strips to rear tires. Screws/attachment devices for rubber strips around tires must not stick out beyond the rubber (ie - studs).
- No chemical altering of tires is permitted
- Front tires may be upgraded to custom 'Skinnies'
- Parental remote control NOT allowed
- Factory gearbox only (NO Belt/Chains)
- Wheelie bars required
- Battery kill switch required on exterior of vehicle
- Additional protective gear such as gloves and full helmet highly recommended. May be worn at parent discretion

TECHNICAL

- All judgment calls, tech decisions, or re-race decisions will be made by event staff.
 - Parents are encouraged to volunteer with basic tasks but will not be involved in any official decisions
 - Event staff may offer a parental vote on decision affecting all teams. Each driver (parent) will be granted 1 vote on the decision by means of 'Show of Hands'
- Only 1 parent/guardian is allowed in the 'Pit Area' during the event. No one under 16 allowed in 'Pit Area'. Additional relatives or fans are not allowed in the 'Pit Area' or Track during the Event.
- All Drivers will compete against each Driver at least once per event.
- Scoring is as follows:
 - 10 points awarded for attending event
 - 1 point awarded for each win
 - Driver with the most points within their class at the end of the event will be declared the winner for that event
 - Driver with the most seasonal points from each event within their class will be declared the Season Champion
- For the 2024 season there will be a max of 12 drivers per class
- If 6 or less Drivers register for a class, each pair of drivers will race TWICE.
